



Rating & Scoring

For each statement, there are three potential scores:

1

It is not clear that the program has a process or evidence that shows the category or sub-category is being met.

2

The program **appears to have some evidence** that the category or sub-category is being met, but there are gaps or limitations in the explanation.

3

The program **appears to have sufficient evidence** to demonstrate that the category or sub-category could be met.

Reviewers should also incorporate information provided regarding **strengths and areas of opportunity** identified by the program.

For all subcategories, **ensure there are adequate comments to support the evaluation.**
